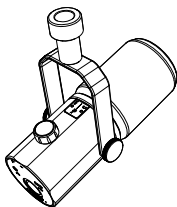
1. RGB light ring mute function
Gently tap the mute key to mute the microphone, meanwhile, the RGB light ring will turn red. Tap once more cancel mute function.
2. Microphone/headphone volume control function
Long touch the key for about 2 seconds, switch the microphone or headset volume control function according to the green indicator light.
3. The RGB light ring will turn green-orange-red in sequence when the volume adjust from low to high.
4. Long touch the key about 7 seconds can turn off the the RGB light ring, long touch 7s again to renew the light effect.



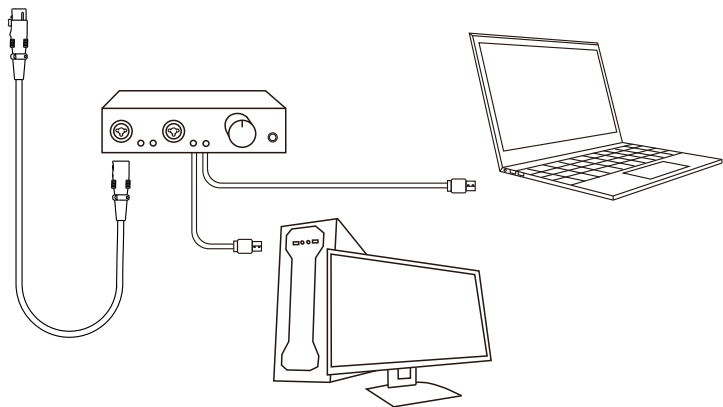

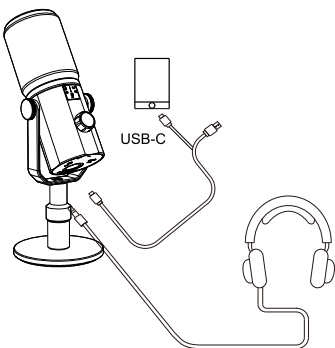
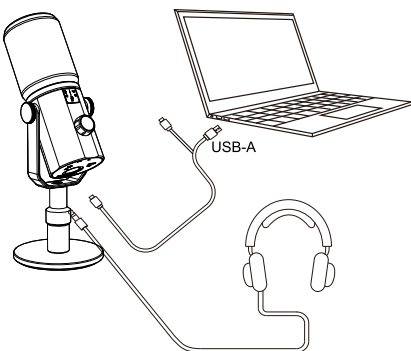
CONNECT VIA XLR



If using the microphone via XLR, simply connect the microphone to an audio interface or mixer and start creating.
*Note, the button function on the microphone will not be activated when using the microphone via XLR



CONNECT VIA USB



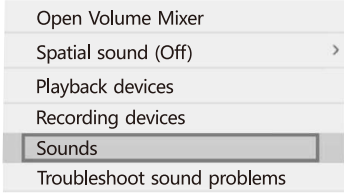
If using the microphone via USB, simply connect the microphone to computer or smartphone and start creating

COMPUTER STEP

Windows

Step 1: Plug the USB microphone into your computer. The computer will automatically recognize **FEELWORLD PM1** and install a driver. And the headphone jack sound is automatically output from FEELWORLD PM1

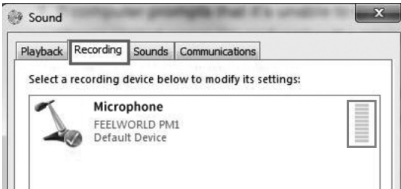
Step 2: Right click the speaker icon at the bottom right of the screen. Click “Sounds”



Step 3: If you need to output headphone jack sound from your computer, select the “Speaker” as sound output



Step 4: Click the Recording tab and select FEELWORLD PM1 as the default device. When you speak to mic, bar-type icon will turn green and bounce.

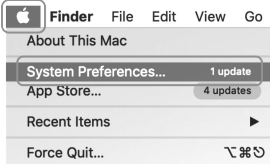


COMPUTER STEP

macOS

Step 1: Plug the USB microphone into your computer. The computer will automatically recognize **FEELWORLD PM1** and instal a driver. And the headphone jack sound is automatically output from FEELWORLD PM1

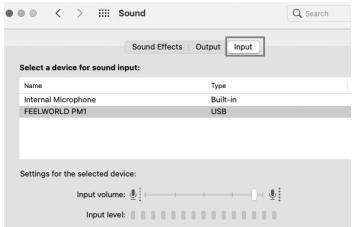
Step 2: Open your **System Preferences**.



Step 3: Click **sound** to display the Sound preference pane.



Step 4: Click the Input tab and select FEELWORLD PM1 as the device for sound input.



Step 5: If you need to output headphone jack sound from your Macbook, select the output from “Internal Speakers” option
