CONNECT VIA USB




If using the microphone via USB, simply connect the microphone to computer or smartphone and start creating

COMPUTER STEP

Windows

Step 1: Plug the USB microphone into your computer. The computer will automatically recognize FEELWORLD PM1 and install a driver. And the headphone jack sound is automatically output from FEELWORLD PM1

Step 2: Right click the speaker icon at the bottom right of the screen. Click "Sounds"



Step 3: If you need to output headphone jack sound from your computer, select the "Speaker"




Step 4: Click the Recording tab and select FEELWORLD PM1 as the default device. When you speak to mic, bar-type icon will turn green and bounce.
